Ph.D in Economics Programme Outline

Duration: 4 years, 8 Semesters

Credit hours: 90

PhD in Economics is a four years programme offering a wide range of specializations. Our PhD programme prepares students to make significant contribution in the field of applied and policy oriented economic analysis. The normal duration for the course work is two years. Students are required to pass their comprehensive examinations in order to progress to the research stage.

Students of PhD Economics must take core courses of 28 credit hours (compulsory) and seven elective courses of 21 credit hours. PhD Dissertation accounts for 41 credit hours.

M.Phil/Ph.D Eligibility Criteria

The following candidates shall be eligible in the given order of priority:

- For M.Phil in Economics, a minimum of B Grade (semester system) or 2nd Division (annual system) in Masters in Economics or 4 years Bachelors (with major in economics) from a recognized university.
- For PhD in Economics, candidates possessing MPhil/MS/Equivalent degree in Economics, Agricultural Economics, Business Administration, Demography, Mathematics, Environmental Economics, Econometrics, Economics and Finance or Statistics with a minimum of B Grade from a recognized university.
- For M.Phil in Economics and Finance, M.A./MSc/B.S(4 years) in Economics, Statistics, Mathematics, MBA or Econometrics with at least 2nd division or B Grade.

Candidates who have published research articles are highly encouraged to apply. Candidates having work experience in economics and statistical areas with public and/or private sector experience are also encouraged to apply.

In service applicants are required to submit the No Objection Certificate issued by the employers before the beginning of the academic session.


